## Presentation of Design Concept

In 2006, the Mason County Transportation Authority (MTA) purchased the old armory building in Shelton with the intention of converting the facility into a combined transit center and community center. With funding appropriated by the Washington State Legislature, MTA hired Foster & Williams Architects, a Mason County-based firm, to lead the design of the new Mason County Transit Community Center.

A Design Fair was held in September to engage the public in designing the new facility, which is intended to be a transit hub and a center for community services and activities for people of all ages.

On January 8, 2009, from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m., the general public is invited to view the Mason County Transit and Community Center conceptual design and discuss the estimated operating and capital costs. Funding strategies to complete the project will also be presented. Presenters will include Representative Kathy Haigh, Dave O'Connell of Mason Transit, members of the Design Team and representation from the Mason County Transit Community Center Task Force. Open public comment and discussion will be encouraged.
