The SECOND AMENDMENT to AGREEMENT GCB1624 entered into between the Washington State Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as "WSDOT"), and Mason County Transportation Authority (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR"), and/or individually referred to as the "PARTY" and collectively referred to as the "PARTIES,"

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, both PARTIES agree to amend AGREEMENT GCB1624 to add \$900,000 in Rural Mobility Transit Tax Equalization Formula funds to Project B.

## **PROJECT B**

**Scope of Work:** Provide operating funding assistance to Mason Transit to sustain general public toute-feviated general public transportation services in the Mason Transit service area, and provide operating funding assistance for regional general public transportation connecting Mason Transit services with Kitsap Transit, Intercity Transit, Squaxin Island Tribal Transit, Jefferson Transit, Grays Harbor Transit and access to transportation connections with Washington State Ferries and Pierce Transit.
