Scope of Work: Provide operating funding assistance to Mason Transit to sustain general public demand response (Dial-A-Ride) public transportation in rural areas not served by route-deviated transit services in the Mason Transit service area; with coordinated services with the Squaxin Island Tribal Transit and Skokomish Tribal general public transportation services.

Scope of Work: Provide operating funding assistance to Mason Transit to sustain general public toute-feviated general public transportation services in the Mason Transit service area, and provide operating funding assistance for regional general public transportation connecting Mason Transit services with Kitsap Transit, Intercity Transit, Squaxin Island Tribal Transit, Jefferson Transit, Grays Harbor Transit and access to transportation connections with Washington State Ferries and Pierce Transit.
