## **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-04**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE MASON TRANSIT AUTHORITY BOARD APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT GCB1954 BETWEEN MASON TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAME.

**WHEREAS**, the Mason Transit Authority ("MTA") Board by motion on November 18, 2014, accepted the Washington State Department of Transportation ("WSDOT") Agreement GCB1954 (the "Agreement") for the replacement of fifteen (15) bus passenger shelters and authorized the General Manager to execute the Agreement as Grantee on behalf of Mason Transit Authority; and

**WHEREAS,** MTA has purchased seven (7) replacement shelters, has no need to replace another eight (8) shelters and has not fully depleted the grant funds; and

**WHEREAS,** MTA does have a need for placing shelters at new stops or stops that do not currently have shelters and WSDOT has agreed to amend the Scope of Work of the Agreement to allow MTA to purchase expansion shelters in order to use the grant to its fullest; and

**WHEREAS,** WSDOT has prepared the First Amendment to the Agreement GCB1954 to amend the Scope of Work.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MASON TRANSIT AUTHORITY BOARD** to approve the First Amendment to Agreement GCB1954 providing for the purchase of eight (8) expansion shelters rather than replacement shelters as originally authorized and approved; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the General Manager is authorized to execute the First Amendment to Agreement GCB1954.
