A RESOLUTION OF THE MASON TRANSIT AUTHORITY BOARD AUTHORIZING THE CLOSING OF THE SETTLEMENT ACCOUNT AT BANK OF AMERICA AND ESTABLISHING A NEW SETTLEMENT ACCOUNT AT COLUMBIA STATE BANK.

WHEREAS, the Mason Transit Authority ("MTA") desires to change financial institutions from Bank of America to Columbia State Bank for payroll purposes, as well as receiving local support, reduction in cost and increase in services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the General Manager is authorized to sign documents required by Bank of America to close the existing account and Columbia State Bank to establish and maintain the new account.
