- 2. The Resolution sets out the terms of appointment and employment of the Manager and the Manager and MCTA agree to be bound by those terms until such time as the parties may agree otherwise or unemployment is terminated under the provisions of that resolution.

RESOLUTION 1992-01

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING DAVID O'CONNELL GENERAL MANAGER OF MASON COUNTY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT AREA AUTHORITY AND FIXING HIS SALARY.

Whereas, the Mason County Public Transportation Benefit Area Authority (MCTA) has the authority pursuant to RCW 36.57A.080 to appoint a general manager for MCTA and to fix his compensation; and

Whereas, in order to attract and retain a person of superior qualifications for the position of general manager it is deemed necessary and convenient to provide severance compensation to the person appointed to said position in the event the MCTA elects to terminate said appointment at will as authorized by law; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that David O'Connell is appointed General Manager and Chief Administrative Officer of the MCTA effective 14 April 1992 on a part time basis and 1 June 1992 on a full time basis until such further action of MCTA, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the compensation shall be set at a monthly rate of \$3,167.00 when he is full time starting 1 June 1992 and at the rate of \$18.00 per hour until that date; and be it further

RESOLVED, that in the event MCTA elects to terminate the appointment made herein, the appointee shall be entitled to receive (3) three months salary, unless the termination is for malfeasance in office in which case termination will be effective upon notice given without severance compensation and in the event the appointee shall elect to terminate his employment with MCTA he shall, by agreeing to take the position, give (45) forty-five days notice of his decision to terminate, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the general manager shall be allowed to take twenty (20) days annual leave with pay and may accumulate one day per month to be used for sick leave and MCTA shall pay the expense of all the medical benefits that he received from his previous employer, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the General Manager shall have the following duties:

- (a) manage MCTA in compliance with the laws of the State of Washington and policies and orders of MCTA in a good and business like manner and in accordance with the standards and practices recognized and accepted in the field;
- (b) attend MCTA meetings and execute the directives of MCTA;
- (c) keep MCTA fully advised as to the financial condition and needs of MCTA and prepare, each year, an

estimate for the ensuing fiscal year of the probable expenses of MCTA, recommend to MCTA what development work should be undertaken, what extensions and additions, is any, should be made during the ensuing fiscal year with an estimate of the costs of such development, work, extensions or additions, certify to MCTA all the bills, allowances, payrolls and claims that may be due contractors and make recommendation to MCTA concerning the establishment of salaries for employees;

- (d) provide administrative support to the citizen's advisory committee and meet with it;
- (e) perform such other duties as may be assigned by MCTA.
