Shelton Matlock Park and Ride Opens

SHELTON, WA – Mason Transit has reopened the Shelton Matlock Park and Ride, located on the Shelton Matlock Road West near its intersection with SR102, after completing renovations to expand and improve the facility.

Shelton Matlock Park and Ride serves bus routes 7 and 63 and has parking for 65 vehicles. Upgrades to the location included increased parking, a shelter for waiting passengers, lights and security cameras.

"With the opening of Shelton Matlock, we are nearing completion of our \$10 million park and ride renovation," explained Amy Asher, general manager of Mason Transit Authority. "This project has tripled the amount of parking available, as well as improving comfort and safety."

The park and ride project was funded through state grants to improve transit safety. The effort has renovated four facilities so far, with just the new Belfair location still to open. The Belfair Park and Ride will serve as a new location for commuters to catch a Mason Transit bus.

Mason Transit Authority serves the Mason County community and connects with area transit systems including Grays Harbor Transit, Intercity Transit (Thurston County), Jefferson Transit, Kitsap Transit, Squaxin Island Transit, Twin Transit, and Sound Transit, which in turn provides connections to the ferries, Amtrak and Greyhound service.
